PLUMPJACK CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2009

One of the most highly sought after houses in Napa Valley, Plumpjack wines capture the essence and depth of Californian winemaking. A classic Plumpjack vintage, the 2009 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon imparts heavy aromas of black cherry, sage, and blackberry cobbler. On the palate juicy Bing cherries, mocha, blackberries fade into a touch of vanilla.

FLOR DE PINGUS TEMPRANILLO 2008

Black cassis, cigar smoke, and bittersweet fudge cream expressed with suave intensity. Old vine tempranillo from Ribera del Duero's resident genius, Peter Sisseck. Earning a massive 96 points from Wine Advocate, only 26 cases of this wine made their way into Chicago.

EL MOLINO RUTHERFORD PINOT NOIR 2006

One of the most fascinating expressions of pinot noir this side of the Atlantic. American by name, Burgundian by nature, El Molino defines what is truly magnificent about this varietal. Cherry cordial, fleshy au jus, and a whisper of black walnut consommé in a vibrantly sexy shell.

BENEGAS-LYNCH CABERNET FRANC 2004

Winemaker Federico Benegas's great great grandfather planted these cab franc vineyards over 100 years ago, some of the first ever planted in Argentina. Never grafted, these old vines are over-stressed to work every bit of terroir and elegance from the grapes. Profoundly bold, aromas of silky chocolate melt into velvety tannins that melt in your mouth.

CÔTE BONNEVILLE CHARDONNAY 2009

Classic American chardonnay from one of Washington state's premier sites, the DuBrul Vineyard in the Yakima Valley. Rich, well integrated oak melts its way through tropical fruit, creamy lemon, and an elegant, unique finish.

EGLY-OURIET PREMIER CRU BRUT NV

Grower Champagne made from 100% old vine pinot meunier grown just west of Reims. Delicate and smooth yet bright and defined, it has a powerfully voluminous character.
